**Instructions**: The words defined by the cryptic clues are to be entered normally in the puzzle grid (heavy bars separate entries), except that eight of them are a letter short and won't fit in the grid unless they receive a gift. So solvers are asked to contribute a letter to each of them. The added letter should spell a new word (not defined by any clue) without changing the letter order of the original word. For example, A might be added to MEN to spell AMEN or MEAN, but not MANE or NAME. The eight letters thus added, taken in order as they occur in across and down words, spell a word appropriate to the title and theme of the puzzle. Answers include one proper name, two foreign words, and one variant spelling. Thanks to Kevin Wald '93 for test-solving and editing this puzzle.
